Eligibility

The minimum requirements of the United Nations Volunteers position are the following:

01. *At least* be 25 years old and over;
02. *At least* possess a first degree from a recognised University;
03. *At least* have five (05) years of consistent and relevant working experience following qualification, and;
04. *Have* knowledge of computer technology and good interpersonal skills.

Conditions of Service

UNV volunteers are provided with a Volunteer Living Allowance (VLA) intended to cover basic needs, housing and utilities, life, health and permanent disability insurance, and a resettlement allowance paid at the end of satisfactory service.

If you have met the aforementioned minimum requirements, please send your up-to-date curriculum vitae (CV) only to our email address cot@unvuganda.org for review and advice on possibilities of registering at our international UNV Roster.

However, should you be interested to serve as a national UNV volunteer and you have met all the aforementioned minimum requirements but you have at least three (03) years of consistent and relevant work experience since qualification, you may as well forward your CV indicating two areas of your professional field and competence for inclusion in our national database.
